DAY 1 | MONACO Monte Carlo Mon Oct 7, 2024 | Depart 6:00 PM



The tiny principality of Monaco, a sovereign state of just under one square mile, has an outsized resume, boasting some of the planet's most expensive real estate, and the world's most prestigious casino.

DAY 2 | ITALY Genoa (Milan) Tue Oct 8, 2024 | 8:00 AM To 8:00 PM



The ancient maritime city of Genoa is renowned for its architecture, landmarks, music and art, as well as fantastic luxury boutiques along Via XX Settembre, traditional markets and incredible Italian food.

DAY 3 - 4 | ITALY Florence / Pisa (Livorno) Wed Oct 9, 2024 | Arrive 8:00 AM Thu Oct 10, 2024 | Depart 8:00 PM



As the birthplace of the Renaissance, Florence and its historic center is bursting with elegant squares, imposing palaces, magnificent churches, incredible art galleries and museums with an abundance of riches.

Wedged into the mouth of a ravine, encircled by sheer cliffs, facing blue waters and where terraced hillsides support lemon groves (and of course limoncello), Amalfi requires a camera with lots of memory.

A warming sun and gentle sea breezes have been attracting visitors to Sorrento for two millennia, and its reputation as a playground of the ancient rich and famous have resulted in lavish villas and palaces.
