DAY 1 *Safari* | SOUTH AFRICA Johannesburg Tue Feb 4, 2025



Welcome to Johannesburg! A Micato Safaris representative will greet you on arrival. You will be escorted to **The Houghton Hotel** for overnight accommodation. Dinner is at your leisure.

DAY 2 *Safari* | SOUTH AFRICA to ZIMBABWE Johannesburg to Victoria Falls Wed Feb 5, 2025



Travel this morning to OR Tambo International Airport and board a scheduled regional flight to **Victoria Falls**. On arrival, we transfer from Victoria Falls Airport to the **Ilala Lodge**. Transfer by road from the hotel to the boat jetty for your **sunset cruise** along the **Zambezi River**. Snacks and refreshments will be served on board before returning to the hotel. (B, L, D)

DAY 3 *Safari* | ZIMBABWE Victoria Falls Thur Feb 6, 2025



Depart the hotel to the rainforest for your **guided** walking tour of the Falls. Lunch is served at the Lookout Café Restaurant. Depart for an authentic steam train experience with dinner served onboard. We head out to the iconic Victoria Falls bridge, with dinner served along the way. Overnight at Ilala Lodge. (B, L, D)

DAY 4 *Safari* | ZIMBABWE to BOTSWANA Victoria Falls to Chobe National Park Fri Feb 7, 2025



Breakfast is served at the hotel. Depart by road for Kasane International Airport, crossing the border into **Botswana**. Your Chobe Lodge representative awaits your arrival and will assist you with your road transfer to the lodge. Lunch is served at the lodge. Afternoon tea is served before departing on your **afternoon game activity**. Dinner and overnight at **Chobe Game Lodge**. (B, L, D)

DAY 5 *Safari* | BOTSWANA Chobe National Park Sat Feb 8, 2025



Home to the largest concentration of elephants in Africa, the Chobe National Park is one of Africa's leading wildlife destinations. Coffee, tea, and biscuits are served at the Tea Station. Depart for a morning game viewing activity followed by breakfast. Lunch is served at the lodge. Afternoon tea is served before departing on your afternoon game activity. Dinner and overnight at **Chobe Game Lodge**. (B, L, D)

DAY 6 *Safari to Cruise* | BOTWANA to SOUTH AFRICA Chobe National Park to Cape Town to *Azamara Quest* Sun Feb 9, 2025 | Depart 5:00 PM



Coffee, tea, and biscuits are served at the Tea Station. Depart for Kasane Airport where your guide will assist with your onward road transfer to Livingstone Airport. (Transfer time is approximately 1 hour 30 minutes). Board a scheduled regional flight to Cape Town. (The flight will be approximately 3 hours and 10 minutes.) Return to Cape Town, and board the *Azamara Quest*. (B)
